FILM SCHOOL is a week-long programme of workshops that teaches the basics of film-making whilst releasing each student's creativity through story-telling. Film School combines theoretical knowledge of

Film Studies, practical hands-on experience of Film-Making, and opportunities for every student; to reflect on their lives, tell their own stories and work together to make their own short film.

Crux media will come in for a week and bring Film School into your school and work with years 9, 10 and 11 to help them look at the students own story and reflect on decisions and choices they have made and may have to make.

CRUX THEATRE inspires and empowers young people to achieve more, to increase their self confidence and self belief and to take responsibility for their actions. The company perform relevant, new

pieces of writing and then follow up their performance with a variety of lessons and drama workshops. A program of workshops can be tailored to suit the needs of specific students, covering the curriculum requirements for Drama, PSHE, Citizenship and RE. Crux Theatre come alongside school staff to provide support in Drama classes where it is needed, and encourage the young people in their theatrical experience.

NOMAD lead PE lessons with the cage: Using a unique Panna-football style to create excitement and interest from the beginning, the cage provides a stage where young people can perform, but also keep them in one area where the team can get engaged with them and have conversations and initiate relationships. Crux Sports also go into the classroom and take RE lessons where there are opportunities to teach, look at moral issues and challenge opinions and misconceptions about God. Looking at topics like 'Respect' and 'Prejudice' and using fun activities to help stimulate discussion and learning. Assemblies are a place where the team can build rapport quickly with young people with their fresh approach to large scale communication.



Nottingham YfC are now trained to deliver and have moderated the **ASDAN CoPE** course. The Certificate of Personal Effectiveness is the QCDA-kitemarked qualification outcome of the ASDAN Award programmes. The qualifications offer imaginative ways of accrediting young people's activities. They promote, and allow centres to record, a wide range of personal qualities, abilities and achievements of young people, as well as introducing them to new activities and challenges. We are able to come in and deliver throughout the school year all the modules to help the students attain the cope qualification. We will also have the students booklets moderated.

exploRE: The Christian Faith is a 12-week programme of study which has been devised for use with students aged 11 to 14 in RE lessons. Its



easy-to-use lesson plans make it an ideal resource for teachers, youth workers and church workers seeking to engage with their local school. The resource has been created by experienced teaching professionals, its approach reflecting guidelines outlined in the non-statutory programme of study for RE in England (2007) and the principles found in Scotland's Curriculum for Excellence (2006). Each lesson unpacks key areas of Christian beliefs and practices, using an exciting array of activities: games, drama, art, discussion and interactive illustrations. The pack also includes a DVD that incorporates vox pops, testimonies and short films. **exploRE: The Christian Faith** gives students the opportunity to investigate the Christian faith in a way that is fresh, engaging and relevant to their everyday lives.



This multi-media resource comprises 14 packed lesson plans and has been devised for use with 11 to 14 year olds as part of their Religious (and Moral) Education lessons. Each lesson encourages students to discover the person of Jesus Christ as recorded in the gospels and explore how these accounts have influenced key Christian beliefs. Most importantly, students are given the opportunity to reflect on their own response to Jesus and discuss questions.
